Salzburg (dpa) - The Mozarteum Foundation in Salzburg has acquired three letters from the Mozart family for a "six-figure amount in line with the market". The most significant new acquisition is a letter from the musical genius Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791) to his seriously ill father on April 4, 1787, the foundation announced on Tuesday.
